Corona-Virus

Attention: Mandatory quarantine for all Arlberg visitors of the past two weeks

From today, 17th of March 2020, 12 am Lech/Zürs as well as the whole Arlberg area is under quarantine. The measures mandated by the government of Vorarlberg **concern all people, who stayed in Lech, Zürs, Stuben, Warth or Schröcken in the past 14 days** – either in a hotel or just for a skiing day.

In order to prevent the spread of the coronavirus, **all these people have to isolate themselves at home for two weeks**. The quarantine is not voluntary, but mandatory and applies to all individuals regardless of the duration of their stay – even if it was for just one skiing day.

All directly affected visitors of Lech/Zürs are obligated to inform all people with whom they had personal direct contact during and after their return from Lech/Zürs, about a possible infection with the coronavirus. These people are also considered being at risk of transmitting the disease and should therefore stay at home and in quarantine voluntarily.

Only by completely and promptly isolating all people, who have been in the Arlberg area in the past two weeks, a further uncontrolled outbreak of the coronavirus can be prevented.

Dear guest, by responsible actions on your part and by staying in quarantine you can prevent other people from being infected.

We sincerely thank you for all your support in the fight against the coronavirus and we would be pleased to welcome you back in calmer times as guest in Lech/Zürs.
